**GENERAL INFORMATION**

**Arrival:** ①

Doors will open at 8:30 a.m. Only WMA staff and judges will be allowed in the building before 8:30. See the map for which doors to enter for art registration and instrumental drop off. Instrumental students will use the Fellowship Hall as their homeroom to store their instruments.

Greeters will be available at the doors and at the information desk in the lobby to answer any questions throughout the day.

Warmup rooms are available throughout the day on a sign-in basis. There are five warmup rooms downstairs and three upstairs. Please sign up immediately upon arrival.

**Art Check In** 😊

Art projects are to be checked in between 8:30-9:00 a.m. at F-20 in the west hallway (Use door #2). All paperwork must accompany the project. This includes the **Artist Statement and Judges' Forms**. (See rules and forms on the website.)

If a scheduled individual is unable to attend, please let the judges know in the performance room. If there is a performance conflict, please go to the room and inform the judges. Group performances take priority over individual performances.

Music entrants must have the **original piece** of music and one photocopy with ALL measures numbered and two judges' sheets filled out to give to the judge(s) upon performance. (See rules and forms on the website.)

## **Performance Dress for Competition**

1. **Young Men:** For individual competition, young men should wear a dress shirt and tie (suit coat optional), dress slacks, and dress shoes.
2. **Young Ladies:** For individual competition, young ladies may wear black/dark dress slacks, or a dress/skirt that comes to the top of the knee or longer, a modest blouse (no low-cut or see-through tops), and dress shoes.
3. **Group Competition:** Although not imperative, it is strongly encouraged that performing groups dress alike or follow a similar color palette within the above guidelines.

## **Non-Performance Dress**

1. **Young Men:** Business Casual (semi-dress slacks, collared shirt, or your group's t-shirts)
2. **Young Ladies:** Business Casual (dress slacks or skirt, denim skirt, modest blouse/shirt)  
Please no jeans.
